









2022-2023 Texas Bluebonnet Award

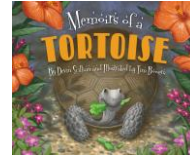

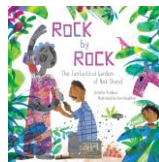

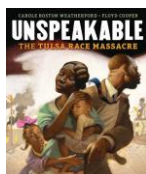
